

Barlow Park Stadium in Parramatta Park, Cairns is a multisport facility and stadium that serves as the home ground for the Northern Pride rugby league team and Cairns Athletics. Fact sheet August 2025

It is owned and operated by Cairns Regional Council and has hosted numerous national rugby league matches and major concerts.

In readiness for the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games, and to ensure the stadium can continue to support Far North Queensland's growing community, Barlow Park Stadium will receive a major upgrade.

Following the Queensland Government's announcement of the 2032 Delivery Plan in March 2025, the Games Independent Infrastructure and Coordination Authority (GIICA) is working with the Queensland and Australian governments and Cairns Regional Council to progress the project to procurement and delivery.

Features and benefits

A new grandstand



The upgrade will see the existing 1,700 seat west stand increase to 5,000 permanent seats, and also include enhanced amenities for spectators.

Current home of Far North Queensland Rugby League (FNQRL), the Northern Pride and Cairns Athletics, among others, upgrades to athlete facilities will enhance opportunities for participation in sports and talent development.
