Stadium to secure its position as the region's premier venue for local, national and international sporting, leisure and entertainment events. The venue is owned and operated by Sunshine Coast Council.

In readiness for the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games, the upgrades are a strategic investment in the Sunshine Coast's future, providing a better visitor experience and more events.

Following the Queensland Government's announcement of the 2032 Delivery Plan in March 2025, the Games Independent Infrastructure and Coordination Authority (GIICA) is working with the Queensland and Australian governments and Council to progress the project to procurement and delivery.

Economic opportunities



The expansion will attract more high-profile events to the Sunshine Coast, driving local tourism and supporting local business.

Supporting grassroots sports



Enhanced facilities will support local clubs and community to develop the next generation of athletes, through increased sporting participation and talent development.

Increased spectator capacity



Increased total permanent seating capacity to more than 10,000 ensures the stadium continues to serve as a valuable year-round asset for the local community, with a total Games-time capacity of up to 20,000 with temporary seating.
