Toowoomba is set to shine on the global stage as the Toowoomba Showgrounds undergoes a transformation ahead of the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

Already a host to a range of national, state and local equestrian events, upgrades will enhance the region's rich heritage and include additional arenas and warm-up facilities, additional and upgraded stables, and an upgraded and lengthened cross-country course.

Following the Queensland Government's announcement of the 2032 Delivery Plan in March 2025, the Games Independent Infrastructure and Coordination Authority (GIICA) is working with the Queensland and Australian governments, Council and the Royal Agricultural Society of Queensland to progress the project for investment decision.
